Tuition Rates and Waivers: Non-School Day Programs

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this regulation is to establish how tuition rates for Minneapolis Public School non-school day programs shall be determined.

II. SETTING TUITION RATES

- A. Tuition rates or fees for enrichment activities offered through Minneapolis Community Services Programs shall be determined by the Director of Community Education or designee. The Director of Community Education shall publish the tuition rate or fee with the listing of enrichment activity offerings.
- B. Tuition rates or fees for participants in school-age child care, or pre-school aged school readiness programs offered through Minneapolis Community Services shall be set by the Director of Community Education with input from the Community Education Advisory Council and the Superintendent.

III. TUITION WAIVERS

- A. The Superintendent, or designee, may waive tuition charged under this policy in cases of extreme hardship on the family.
 - 1. The Superintendent designates the Director of Community Education to determine when participants who are enrolled in community services activities for which tuition or fees would be charged may have such tuition or fees waived. Participants may request a waiver from the Director of Community Education.
 - 2. The Superintendent authorizes the Director of Community Education to establish a sliding fee scale for children participating in pre-school aged school readiness programs offered through Minneapolis Community Services, or to waive fees.
- B. In the event that the Superintendent does not grant a tuition fee waiver the family may petition the Board of Education for such a fee waiver.
- C. The Superintendent may establish a sliding-fee scale for any tuition or fee based program.



D. No waiver of any tuition or fee shall be given to any student or participant who is enrolled in a program or activity under an F-1 student status visa.
