ORGANIZATIONAL PLAN

I. GENERAL PURPOSE

Schools shall be organized to serve the educational needs of students with a program of instruction from kindergarten through grade 12.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Minneapolis Public Schools shall be classified as follows:

- A. Elementary schools with a program from kindergarten through grade five, or any portion thereof. Units with more than or less than six grades may be organized to fit the needs of a particular locality or program.
- B. K-8 schools with both elementary (K-5) and secondary (6-8) programs.
- C. Secondary school means any school ordinarily in grade six through twelve or any portion thereof such as:
 1. Middle schools with grades six, seven and eight.
 2. Senior high schools with grades nine through twelve.
- C. Other grade organizations as may be recommended by the Superintendent.
