

LEARNING/INSTRUCTION

Length of School Day

TEACHERS

The normal work day of teachers will be no longer than 7 3/4 hours, including a one-half hour duty-free lunch period.

Teachers will report for duty not less than twenty (20) minutes before the opening of school in the morning. Generally, teachers shall remain until 3:45 p.m. Exceptions will be made for variations in scheduling. If teachers do leave earlier, it is assumed that it is for extraordinary personal and/or professional reasons.

Meetings called by principals, department chairpersons, and central administrative staff may necessitate a longer teacher's day.
