Summer and Out of School Time Programs

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish the policy regarding educational opportunities for students outside of the normal school year and hours.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT

- A. As resources permit, the District may maintain summer schools and before or after school hours programming to serve the educational needs of students.
- B. Admission to out of school time programs and summer schools shall be in accordance with regulations established by the Superintendent.
- C. Courses for high school credit may be offered during the summer months or out of school time hours. Students concurrently enrolled in high school or enrolled in high school in the semester preceding the summer school in which credit courses are taken may earn high school credit for courses satisfactorily completed.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. The Superintendent is authorized to promulgate regulations to implement this policy.
- B. The Superintendent, or designee, shall assure that summer and out of school time programs available to students are communicated to parents.
