Communications with the Public

It is the responsibility and desire of the Board of Education, elected by the citizens of Minneapolis, that two-way channels of communication be kept open at all times between the school system and the public. The Board will continuously attempt to create and maintain schools that reflect the educational interests of pupils and will do its best to respond to the public's wishes and to keep the people informed of the affairs of the school system.

To help achieve the above goals every effort must be made to keep the public informed through the mass media, through community organizations and through school publications and reports with such purposes as the following:

- 1) To educate about the benefits of education;
- 2) To keep the public informed on goals of the Minneapolis Public Schools;
- 3) To provide an understanding of the services of the individual schools and administration;
- 4) To tell how education contributes to the economy of the whole community.
