I. PURPOSE

The Board of Education values cooperation between the District and community service organizations and other agencies for the purpose of providing community information to our students' families. The purpose of this policy is to establish how community information may be provided while protecting the interests of students and the ability of the schools to provide the best possible education to those students.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. The District may establish a carry-home flyer distribution program.
- B. The carry-home flyer distribution program restrictions do not apply to school communications notices, including those issued by the school's official parent-school organizations.
- C. Non-School publications announcing community services, special events and public meetings sponsored by community service organizations and other agencies may be communicated through a District carry-home flyer distribution program if the publication and agency meets district criteria.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. The Superintendent is authorized to promulgate regulations to implement this policy.
- B. The Superintendent, or designee, shall publish the criteria and procedures of a carry-home flyer distribution program to inform non-school groups of the terms of the program.
