

COMMUNITY RELATIONSShared Time - Programs in Non-Minneapolis Public Schools

The Minneapolis Board of Education will pay tuition to other public school districts for pupils in shared time programs in non-Minneapolis Public Schools only when there is a comparable number of students attending shared time programs in Minneapolis Public Schools for which other districts are paying tuition to the Minneapolis Public Schools.

The Minneapolis Board of Education will grant permission enabling other districts to claim foundation aid for Minneapolis resident pupils who attend shared time programs in other districts only on a reciprocal basis. There must be an equal number of students attending Minneapolis Public Schools shared time programs for which other districts have granted permission to the Minneapolis Public Schools to claim foundation aid for out-of-district students in Minneapolis Public School programs.
