Grade Level Promotion

The practice of promoting students based on their chronological ages has been eliminated in the Minneapolis Public Schools.

Since the needs of individual students vary within and across grade levels the Minneapolis Public Schools is committed to monitoring the basic skills achievement of students at each grade level.

Promotional gates will be established at grades K, 2, 5, and 9. Students must achieve proficiency on grade level benchmark tests to be promoted to levels 1, 3, 6 or 8. Students must achieve proficiency on high school benchmark tests first administered at grade nine as a requirement for graduation from high school.
