I. PURPOSE

This policy establishes the conditions necessary for a student to meet the academic standards of a course through an assessment process.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

Minnesota Statutes Section 120B.021 authorizes school districts to establish and maintain a system for awarding course credit to student who demonstrate and successfully meet the academic standards of a course required by law for high school graduation in Minnesota. Minneapolis Public School students may earn course credit by successfully demonstrating that they have met the academic standards of a course by following procedures established by the Superintendent.

III. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent will develop procedures for granting course credit by assessment.
