Credit for High School Courses

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish the conditions under which a student not otherwise enrolled in a Minneapolis Public School High School may earn credit towards graduation. Minneapolis Public School Students have the opportunity to acquire credits toward graduation by participating in on-line learning, enrollment and completion of high school courses while a pre-high school student, or by assessment.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Any student who satisfactorily completes a high school course shall receive secondary course credit.
- B. Any high school credit earned by a student shall be counted toward satisfaction of the graduation requirements of the district.
- C. Any high school credit earned by a student shall be included on their official transcript.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. The Superintendent is authorized to promulgate regulations and rules for the implementation of this policy.
