Evaluation of Piloted Courses

I. PURPOSE

The Board of Directors expects the administration and faculty of the district to evaluate regularly the education program. Such evaluation may be expected to lead to recommendations for modifications of practices or courses, changes or revisions in content and new courses. New courses introduced as piloted courses under district policy must be evaluated in light of the needs of our students and meeting the district's mission and strategic plans.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Courses that have been introduced through a pilot program under district policy shall be evaluated according to the evaluation plan adopted by the Superintendent, but no less than annually.
- B. The Superintendent may make recommendations to the Board of Directors to adopt classes for which the Superintendent, in his or her professional opinion, requires no pilot program, but which have been evaluated by the Superintendent, or Superintendent's designee.
- C. Piloted courses that have met the criteria set by the Superintendent's evaluation plan shall be presented for adoption by the Board of Directors upon recommendation of the Superintendent.
