#### **I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this regulation is to establish definitions that apply to Policy 4010 and its attendant regulations.

#### **II. DEFINITIONS**

A. “serious communicable or infectious diseases” shall include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS)
- (2) Enteric E coli (Escherichia coli-Infection)(E.Coli 0157:H7)
- (3) Giardiasis
- (4) Hemolytic Uremic syndrome (HUS)
- (5) Hepatitis A, B or C
- (6) Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
- (7) Influenza
- (8) Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- (9) Meningitis, bacterial and viral
- (10) Pertussis (whooping cough)
- (11) Sexually transmitted diseases (STDs)
- (12) Tuberculosis

B. “sexually transmitted infection or sexually transmitted diseases” shall include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS)
- (2) Chlamydia
- (3) Genital Herpes
- (4) Genital Warts
- (5) Gonorrhea
- (6) Herpes, Herpes Simplex Virus (HSV)
- (7) Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)
- (8) Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- (9) Syphilis
