Regulation 5392 B

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this regulation is to establish the rules for receipt of diplomas and records for students who complete requirements for graduation after their originally established graduation date.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF REGULATION

- A. A student who completes the necessary requirements for graduation after the date of the originally scheduled graduation date for the student's class within twelve (12) months of that date shall
 - 1. receive a diploma bearing the originally scheduled date.
 - 2. have their cumulative records reflect the originally scheduled graduation date, and be filed with the records of others who graduated on that original date.

- B. A student who completes the necessary requirements for graduation more than (12) months after the originally scheduled date or their graduation shall:
 - 1. receive a diploma bearing the general graduation date for the year in which the requirements are completed; and
 - 2. have their cumulative records reflect the date of the general graduation for the year in which the requirements are completed, and
 - 3. have their cumulative records filed with the records of others who graduate on that same date.

- C. A student who qualifies for special education who continues to receive special education services thereafter shall upon exit from receipt of services receive the diploma bearing the graduation date of the ceremony in which they were eligible to participate.
