Sale of Tickets

Regulation 5540 B

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this regulation is to establish the parameters for permissible sale of tickets on district premises.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF REGULATION

- A. Sale of tickets on district premises for admission to activities or events authorized by the schools for school purposes shall be made under the supervision and with the permission of the Principal and in accordance with any district policies or Superintendent's regulations, or school rules. Such activities include:
 - 1. Student performances;
 - 2. Fund raising events sponsored by school or district approved student activities;
 - 3. Fund raising events sponsored by the school's official parent group or booster clubs.
- B. Sale of tickets on district premises for admission to activities or events not covered by ¶ II.A. shall only be allowed with the permission of the Superintendent or Superintendent's delegee.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. The Principal or site administrator is responsible for approving or disapproving of requests from student groups or school staff to sell tickets to events or activities.
- B. The Principal or site administrator shall work with parent groups or booster clubs to determine the time and place of any sales of tickets to events or activities sponsored by that group or those clubs.
- C. The Principal is responsible for disseminating any additional school rules regarding sales of tickets to the appropriate parties, i.e. student activity groups, parent groups and booster clubs.
- D. The Principal shall forward for approval or disapproval any requests for permission to sell tickets to other events or activities to the Superintendent or Superintendent's designee.
- E. School staff and student activity advisors are responsible for obtaining permission from the Principal or site administrator prior to selling tickets to activities or events.
