## Athletic Contests

### **Regulation 5560 B**

### **I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this regulation is to establish limitations on participation in athletic contests or activities and to establish the responsibility for management of athletic contests occurring on district premises.

### **II. LIMITATIONS ON PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC CONTESTS**

- A. No district sponsored team may participate in an athletic contest without the approval of the Director of Athletics.
- B. No district sponsored team may participate in an athletic contests or scrimmages with a team representing an institution of learning higher than a secondary school.
- C. No district sponsored team may participate in an athletic contest unless it is in the charge of a faculty representative of its school, or a person designated by the District Director of Athletics.

### **III. MANAGEMENT OF ATHLETIC CONTESTS**

- A. Unless otherwise ordered by the District Director of Athletics, the Principal or site administrator of a school shall be responsible for the management of all athletic contests or activities played at its facilities, whether or not such facilities are contiguous with the school building.
- B. The Director of Athletics is authorized to make administrative rules for the safe and efficient management of all interscholastic athletic events or contests which shall be administered by the home school's administration.
- C. Principals may make such arrangements necessary for the safety of participants, staff and attendees of athletic program events and contests in excess of those required by the Director of Athletics as the principal believes necessary.
