Work Release and Student Internship Programs

Students enrolled in approved school sponsored and supervised work release or internship programs will be released from a portion of the defined school day for the purpose of obtaining occupational experience. The occupational experience may be in the form of planned observations and/or government or private sector employment.

No student will be placed in government or private sector employment in violation of the rules and regulations of the Fair Labor Standards Act and/or the Minnesota Wage and Hour Laws.

Students will receive school credit for occupational experience which is school sponsored and supervised. Financial compensation provided by participating employers will not affect the granting of credit.
