

LEARNING/INSTRUCTIONReleased Time for Religious Instruction

A student may be excused if it is the wish of the parent, guardian, or other person having responsibility for such student. The student may attend for a period or periods not exceeding in the aggregate three hours in any week, a school for religious instruction conducted and maintained by some church, or association incorporated under the laws of the state, or any auxiliary thereof, such school to be conducted and maintained in a place other than a public school building, and in no event, in whole or in part, at public expense.
