

COMMUNITY RELATIONSFees

Rental charge shall be made in accordance with the schedule of rental rates published annually.

1. A temporary "on-sale" license for the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquors may be issued by the municipality to a club or charitable, religious, or non-profit organization.
2. It will be issued for the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquor on school grounds and in school buildings subject to such terms, including a license fee, as the municipality shall prescribe.
3. Failure to comply with this license regulation is a misdemeanor.
4. Although permissive legislation exists, the Minneapolis School Board does prohibit the sale of non-intoxicating malt liquor on or around school buildings and grounds.
