

LEARNING/INSTRUCTIONPost Secondary/Adult Education

The Minneapolis Schools' Board of Education endorses the concept that education is a lifelong process, which the public schools have a responsibility to foster. Furthermore, the people in the community need to be directly involved in the planning of the educational activities designed for their benefit.

Insofar as the resources will permit, the Board of Education will maintain programs beyond the elementary-secondary dimension in such areas as will serve these needs.

Admission to post secondary and adult education programs or classes shall be in accordance with regulations established by the Superintendent and subject to payment of tuition according to rates established by the Minnesota State Board of Vocational Technical Education in accordance with State rules, regulations or statutes.
