I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish the authority for promulgation of regulations and to establish the authority of regulations.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Unless otherwise stated in a policy adopted by the Board, the Superintendent is authorized to promulgate such regulations as the Superintendent deems necessary for the proper implementation of the policy.
- B. Generally, regulations are not adopted by the Board. However, the Board retains the authority to repeal any regulation it finds in conflict with the underlying policy.
- C. The Board shall formally adopt a regulation if required to do so by law.
- D. The Board may formally adopt a regulation if requested to do so by the Superintendent.
- E. If the Board formally adopts a regulation it has the force and effect of Board policy, and must follow the rules for policy revision, suspension, or repeal.
- F. The Superintendent, or Superintendent's designee shall make copies of all regulations available for review by the Board.
