Requirements for Use:

Ice Arena

Regulation 1650 B

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this regulation is to assure that school sites, facilities and district departments are in compliance with the instructional, health and safety regulations of the state departments and agencies with oversight of public ice arena facilities. Although the District attempts to maintain a safe environment around the ice area, and minimum safety requirements are established under this regulation, the public should understand the inherent risks involved in using the ice arena.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF REGULATION

- A. General supervision of the facility is afforded by a designated district employee for all uses. Fees from permit users will support this requirement when the facility is being used by non-district organizations or persons.
- B. The district may offer “open skate” times available to all persons for a fee.
- C. Permit users may be required to supply additional supervisory personnel when the activity proposed or the age of the participants warrants additional supervision. Decisions regarding requirement of additional supervision shall be the responsibility of the district.
- D. Only persons trained and specifically permitted by the facilities staff may use the Zamboni equipment on the ice surface.
- E. Security measures, including hiring off-duty police security, may be required of permit holders if the event size or time warrants such additional security. Decisions regarding additional security shall be the responsibility of the district.
- F. The district may impose additional safety rules regarding equipment and use of the facility. Such rules shall be posted and available to all permit holders.
- G. Persons reserving ice time who do not cancel at least 48 (forty-eight) hours in advance will be responsible for paying the fees for the time scheduled.
