### Residency

The residence of the students of Minneapolis Public Schools, Special School District No. 1, should be determined periodically by the Board of Education. For information with regard to the exact location, see "Street and Avenue Guide to School Attendance Areas".

For the specific purpose of determining school attendance area residency of a student under 18 years of age and whose parents live in Minneapolis, the residence of the student shall be the parental home. When students live apart from their parents, they shall be required to attend the school designated for the area of the parental home unless a transfer is granted. The parental home shall be deemed to be the place of actual place of residence of a student's parents or actual place of residence of a custodial parent or legal guardian pursuant to the decree of a court of competent jurisdiction.

Consistent with the least restrictive environment policy, handicapped students will attend the school designated for the area of parental residence. Attendance at another school or at one of the citywide alternative programs will require that procedures for assessment and individual education program planning be followed. (See Policy 5700.)

Prekindergarten handicapped children will attend the program designed to meet their special needs regardless of area of residence.
